SKATEPARK RULES – BICYCLES & SCOOTERS

The following guidelines and rules have been established to promote safe and enjoyable use of the Skatepark facility by BICYCLE and manually operated SCOOTER users. It is the responsibility of all users to know, understand, and abide by these rules and guidelines. Please conduct yourself accordingly.

- The Harrisburg Township Park District Skatepark is unsupervised. Using a Bicycle or Scooter can be a HAZARDOUS ACTIVITY that may result in SERIOUS INJURY. You assume all risk and responsibility for the use of the Skatepark at the Harrisburg Township Park District.
- Ride at your own risk.
- This facility is unsupervised and self-policed. Reckless and destructive riding jeopardizes the safety of others.
- “Mountain Bikes” are not allowed.
- Bicycle pegs and Bicycle kickstands are not allowed.
- Helmets, knee pads, elbow pads and wrist guards are strongly recommended.
- Inspect the premises before use. Snow, ice, wet surfaces, litter, and debris may affect riding conditions.
- Do not use ramps and runs until they are clear of other users. Do not ride against traffic.
- Be respectful of other users. Be a role model and mentor young users.
- All organized events require prior written approval of the Harrisburg Township Park District.
- Spectators are required to observe from outside the concrete pad.
- The use or placement of any unauthorized equipment or obstacles is prohibited.
- Personal ramps, rails, or other equipment or obstacles are not allowed.
- Waxing of Skatepark surfaces is prohibited.
- Graffiti, tagging, littering, and stickers are prohibited. Vandalism of the Skatepark will cause the Skatepark to be closed until repairs are made.
- The facility is open during normal park operating hours unless otherwise indicated.
- If the Skatepark or its equipment needs attention or repair, please contact the park Executive Director at 618.201.6352 or call the Park Office at 618.252.2111 to report any problems.
- The following are not permitted in the Skatepark:
 1. Alcoholic beverages
 2. Glass containers of any kind
 3. Smoking and/or tobacco products
 4. Food and beverages
 5. Pets
 6. Profanity
 7. Indecent Actions

The Harrisburg Township Park District reserves the right to close the Skatepark facility at any given time for any reason. The Park District also reserves the right to ask persons to leave the facility and restrict entry to the facility if rules are not followed and unsafe behavior is observed.
